Please remember that children need waterproofs (if you have them) and a change of footwear; it is quite muddy at this time of year, so wellies may be best. We also ask that children wear long sleeves and trousers, rather than shorts and t-shirt, in order to reduce the risk of ticks in open woodland, as well as nettle stings and scrapes from low level branches.
