### **Forest School**

After the Easter holidays the children will be returning to Acorn Bank for their Forest School sessions. As we will be visiting the woodland, the children need to ensure they bring appropriate clothing into school for these sessions.

Children need long sleeved tops, long trousers, waterproofs, a change of footwear - wellies may be best for this time of year. We ask that children wear long sleeves and trousers, rather than shorts and t-shirt, in order to reduce the risk of ticks in open woodland, as well as nettle stings and scrapes from low level branches. Please refer to the dates on the calendar over the page for exact dates of these sessions, as not all will be on Wednesdays (the older children will have some sessions on Friday mornings).

Spare wellies - if you have any spare children's wellingtons at home that you no longer need, we would be very grateful for them in school. We already have some smaller ones but are particularly short of sizes 12+.

### **Open Evening**

Next Wednesday (27th March), we are holding an open evening after school. It will run from 3.30pm to 4.15pm, with all parents welcome to come into school to look at books and displays, chat to class teachers and find out what we've been up to. This is not in place of Parents' Evenings which will still be taking place the second week back after the Easter holidays. Katie will be in touch at the beginning of next week to arrange bookings.

### **Eden Camp**

Children in Years 3 to 6 will be visiting Eden Camp next week on Tuesday 26th March. **We will be setting off at the earlier than usual time of 8.15am** and will be aiming to be back at school around 4pm.
